

Total Annual Average Recorded Wealth Transfer, 1998-2002



Annual Average Transfer per Recorded Probated Estate, 1998-2002






Age in Iowa, 1900-2000



Age Group by Sex for Majority* Residents, Iowa, 2000.




Age Group by Sex for Minority* Residents, Iowa, 2000.




Percent of Population by Age Group, Iowa, 2000


Demographic Conveyor Belt


