 Get Cooperation of Local Newspaper, Radio Stations, and Public Access Television

- Do Special Shows Highlighting Charitable Giving in Your Area
- Create "Spots" on Local Radio Station at Least 3 Times a Year

4 Examples of Fundraising

- Education Foundation
 Raffle: 500 tickets for \$50 = \$25,000 ie
 \$12,500 for awards, \$12,500 for foundation
- County Hospital Foundation
 20 Dream Vacations: goal 300 tickets @ \$100 sold 180 = \$12,000 cost, \$6000 for foundation
- Greater Jefferson County Foundation
 Golf Tournament plus dinner for 2
- Jefferson County Civic Center, Inc.
 \$5.2 million raised using appreciated asset contributions and pledges over 5 years
