- Population 1,500
- Incorporated in 1881
- Located on Highway
 141 in the SW Corner of
 Carroll County in West Central Iowa.
- Approximately 90 Minutes from Des Moines, Omaha, Sioux City, Fort Dodge and Ames.

Characteristics

- Unconsolidated K-12 School District With 530 Students
- Community Owned Regional Healthcare Center
- Municipal Organizations:

Electric, Natural Gas, Water, Sewer, Internet Communications, Telephone, TV/FM, Housing, and Public Library

Manning Community Foundation

- Founded in 1979
- * Formed to Build Recreation Center With Indoor Pool, Basketball and Racquetball Courts.
- Purchased, Renovated, and Sold Vacant Storefronts on Main Street.
- * Raised Funds to Purchase Ground for the Greatwestern Park (A 300 Acre County Park).

West Central Healthcare Foundation



- Founded in 1989
- Generated Donations to Build Family Healthcare. Clinic - Served by 3 Physicians, 2 Physician Assistants, and Related Staff.
- Assisted In Raising Seed Money for a \$4.4 Million Renovation of the Manning Regional Healthcare Center.

Manning Betterment Foundation

- Founded in 1993
- Converted the Manning Development For-Profit Corporation to a Not-for-Profit.
- Serves as Pass Through for Grants Awarded to Community Projects Such As Child Daycare.
- Helped Generate Funds to Allow Construction of 2 Four-plex Apartment Buildings.

Manning Heritage Foundation

- Founded in 1989
- Purchased 1915 National Register Farmsite.
- Supports Heritage

- Generated Funds to Bring Authentic German Hausbarn from Germany to Manning.
- Constructed Restaurant and Konference Centre Adjacent to the Hausbarn.
