



## Race and Hispanic Origin in Iowa's Counties, 1980 - 2010

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Race information has been included in the decennial census for many decades. In 2010, the census questionnaire included five specific race categories as well as a sixth category of "Other." In reporting the race data, the information from the census is usually provided in tables that have six "one race alone" categories (respondents who selected only one specific category or "Other") along with a seventh category of those selecting two or more of the individual categories (Table 1). The 2000 census was the first time that data were reported for respondents selecting multiple race categories.

In 2010, more than 91 percent of Iowans selected White as their only race choice. The White group in Iowa is far larger than any of the other race groups (Black, 2.9%; American Indian, 0.4%; Asian, 1.7%; Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, 0.1%; Other, 1.8%) (Table 1). Although Whites increased in number between 2000 and 2010, their proportion in the population decreased during that period. All the other race groups increased in both number and proportion during the decade (Figure 1, Table 1).

Although Iowa's counties all have large White majorities, they vary significantly in the racial composition of minorities. In 2010, Blacks in Iowa had the largest percentages in highly urban counties (Black Hawk, 8.9%; Scott, 7.1%; Polk, 6.0%; Des Moines County, 5.1%) with counts exceeding 25,000 in Polk and 11,000 in Black Hawk and Scott (Table 1). Most counties reported fewer than one percent American Indians with the exceptions of Tama (7.5%), Woodbury (2.2%), and Monona (1.0%). Jefferson County reported the largest percentage of Asians (8.5%)

followed by Story (6.0%), Buena Vista (5.6%), Johnson (5.2%), and Polk (3.5%). The highest concentrations of Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders were in Buena Vista (0.5%) and Jackson (0.4%). Thirteen percent of the residents of Crawford County chose Other as their race category as did at least five percent of those living in Buena Vista, Louisa, Marshall, Muscatine, and Woodbury Counties. Although relatively few Iowans selected more than one race category, three percent of those in Woodbury and Scott Counties did as well as two percent of residents in Black Hawk, Des Moines, Johnson, Linn, Marshall, Polk, and Tama Counties (Table 1).

Information on Hispanic or Latino Origin is included in the census. This is considered an ethnic designation and *not* a race category and is included in a separate question on the census form. More than 151,000 Iowans (5.0%) said they were of Hispanic Origin, making this the largest minority group in the state (Figure 1, Table 1). Twenty-four percent of residents in Crawford County as well as nearly 23 percent of those in Buena Vista said they were of Hispanic Origin. Ten percent or more of those in Clarke, Franklin, Louisa, Marshall, Muscatine, and Woodbury also selected the Hispanic Origin designation. Polk County counted more than 32,000 Latino residents and Woodbury tallied nearly 14,000.

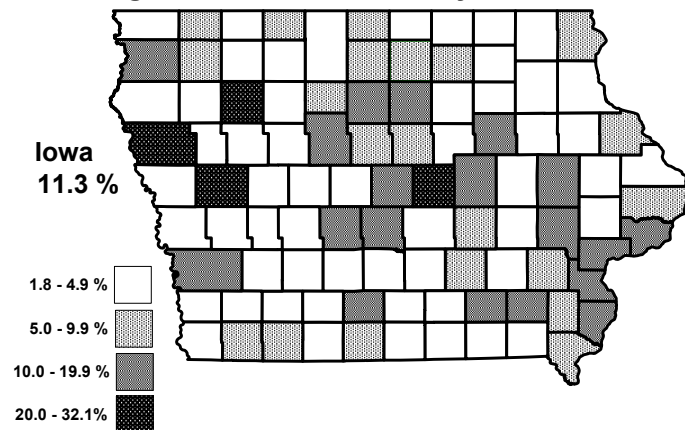


Figure 3. Percent Minority 1990

In 2010, residents of Iowa who selected only the White race category and who were not Hispanic (2,701,123; 88.7%) decreased by 9,221 from 2000 (Table 2). In contrast, minority groups (races other than White along with Hispanics) increased by 129,252 during the decade and were 11.3 percent of the Iowa total in 2010. All but one county had a larger percentage of minorities in 2010 than 10 years earlier. Buena Vista County counted 32.1 percent minorities, three others (Crawford, 26.6%; Marshall, 21.8%; Woodbury, 22.4%) exceeded 20 percent, and 19 others recorded 10 percent or more minorities (Figure 2, Table 2). The 2010 data for minorities stand in stark contrast to 1990 when the state recorded 4.1 percent minorities and no county had even 10 percent minority counts (Figure 3). Even with the minority gains of the past two decades, Iowa remains a predominantly White state and much less diverse than many other states and the nation as a whole (Figure 4, Tables 1-2).

Figure 1. Race and Hispanic Origin, Iowa, 1980 - 2010

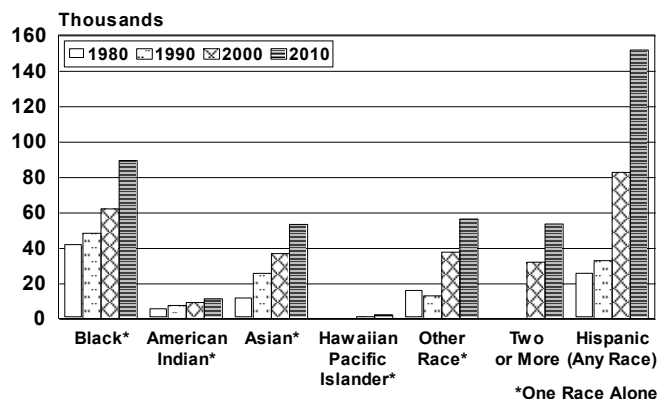

Figure 2. Percent Minority 2010

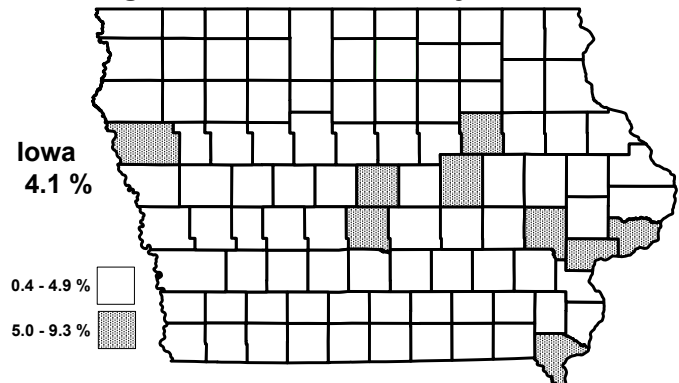
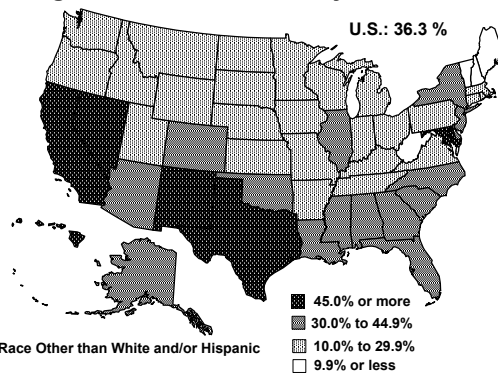
