- 2. Inventory and Support Local & Regional Entrepreneurial Assets and Ask Entrepreneurs What They Need to Succeed
- 3. Publicly Recognize Entrepreneurial Successes with Awards, Business Plan Competitions, and Success Stories
- 4. Annually Support Entrepreneurial Educational, Training, Technical Assistance, and Development Activities
- 5. Establish and Support Entrepreneur Coaching and Mentoring Networks
- 6. Create Endowments, Seed Capital Tools, and Sustainable Funding Resources for Supporting Local Entrepreneurs and Entrepreneur Development Initiatives
